Revelation 3:14-22

14"To the angel of the church in Laodicea write: The Amen, the faithful and true Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God, says this: 15 `I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot; I wish that you were cold or hot. 16 So because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of My mouth. 17 Because you say, "I am rich, and have become wealthy, and have need of nothing," and you do not know that you are wretched and miserable and poor and blind and naked,

CHRIST'S TITLE (Rev. 3:14)

CHRIST'S TITLE EMPHASIZES THE TRUTHFULNESS AND ORIGIN OF THE MESSAGE

CHRIST'S REPROVES THE CHURCH (Rev. 3:15-16)

"LUKEWARM"

15 `I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot; I wish that you were cold or hot. 16 `So because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of My mouth.

Revelation 3:15-16 (NASB)

THE PROBLEM (Rev. 3:17)

17 `Because you say, "I am rich, and have become wealthy, and have need of nothing," and you do not know that you are wretched and miserable and poor and blind and naked,

Revelation 3:17 (NASB)

"The basis for their lukewarm spirituality was that they were immensely wealthy, and this led to self-sufficiency and complacency, a deadly combination for Christians. Because they were materially rich, they assumed they were spiritually rich. The problem however, was not wealth per se but the smug self satisfaction it endangered. They had succumbed to their own affluent lifestyle, and they did not know it" (Grant R. Osborne).

THE SOLUTION (Rev. 3:18-20)

"GO SHOPPING!" (v. 18)

18 I advise you to buy from Me gold refined by fire so that you may become rich, and white garments so that you may clothe yourself, and that the shame of your nakedness will not be revealed; and eye salve to anoint your eyes so that you may see. Revelation 3:18 (NASB)

"REPENT" (v. 19)

19 `Those whom I love, I reprove and discipline; therefore be zealous and repent. Revelation 3:19 (NASB)

"ACCEPT CHRIST'S INVITATION" (v. 20)

20 `Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and will dine with him, and he with Me. Revelation 3:20 (NASB)

THE PROMISE (v. 21)

21 `He who overcomes, I will grant to him to sit down with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.

Revelation 3:21 (NASB)

THE ONE WHO OVERCOMES WILL BE GIVEN A RULING POSITION WITH CHRIST IN HIS KINGDOM.
