Jesus' Seven Words from the Cross

1. The First Word (Forgiveness): "Father, forgive them" (Luke 23:34).
2. The Second Word (Salvation): "Today, you will be with Me in Paradise" (Luke 23:42, 43).
3. The Third Word (Affection): "Woman, behold your son!" (John. 19:25-27)
4. The Fourth Word (Anguish): "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me" (Matthew 27:46)
5. The Fifth word (Suffering): "I Thirst." (John 19:28)
6. The Sixth Word (Victory): "It is finished!" (John 19:30)
7. The Seventh Word (Contentment): "Father, into Your hands I commit My spirit." (Luke 23:46)
