Now all these things are from God, who **reconciled** us to Himself through Christ, and gave us the ministry of **reconciliation**, 19. namely, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and He has committed to us the word of **reconciliation** (2 Cor. 5:16-19).
