

## WHY PAUL WROTE ROMANS?

TO INTRODUCE HIMSELF AND HIS MESSAGE TO THE CHRISTIANS AT ROME, SEEKING TO ENLIST THEIR SUPPORT FOR THE PROPOSED MISSION TO SPAIN

### **ROMANS 15:22-23**

22 For this reason I have often been hindered from coming to you; 23 but now, with no further place for me in these regions, and since I have had for many years a longing to come to you

### **ROMANS 15:24-25**

24 whenever I go to Spain – for I hope to see you in passing, and to be helped on my way there by you, when I have first enjoyed your company for a while -25 but now I am going to Jerusalem serving the saints.

#### **ROMANS 15:26**

For Macedonia and Achaia have been pleased to make a contribution for the poor among the saints in Jerusalem.

### **ROMANS 15:27**

27 Yes, they were pleased to do so, and they are indebted to them. For if the Gentiles have shared in their spiritual things, they are indebted to minister to them also in material things.

## **ROMANS 15:28-29**

28 Therefore, when I have finished this, and have put my seal on this fruit of theirs, I will go on by way of you to Spain. 29 And I know when I come to you, I will come in the fulness of the blessing of Christ.
