WE MUST LEARN TO MAINTAIN THE RIGHT BALANCE BETWEEN THE SPIRITUAL EXERCISE OF COMMUNION WITH JESUS AND THE PRACTISING OF OUR RELIGION IN ACTIVE SERVICE.

WE TRULY WELCOME JESUS BY LISTENING TO HIS WORD.

The one thing that cannot be taken away from a person is fellowship with Jesus.
