THE IMPERATIVE

CHRISTIANS MUST LIVE IN RELATION TO THE EXALTED CHRIST.

THE IMPERATIVE

"Keep seeking the things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Set your mind on the things above, not on the things that are on earth" (Col. 3:1,2 NASB).
