IF GENTILES ARE WITHOUT LAW, HOW CAN THEY BE REGARDED AS HAVING SINNED?

"for where there is no law there is no transgression." (Rom. 4:15)

THE LAW

FROM VERSE ROMANS 2:12, WE CAN CONCLUDE THAT THE LAW IS THE MEASURE OF DIVINE JUDGMENT.

WHAT IS SIN?

THE GREEK TERM HARMATIA – LITERALLY MEANS "A MISSING OF THE MARK"

WHAT IS SIN?

SIN IS TRANSGRESSION OF, OR THE LACK OF CONFORMITY TO GOD'S LAW, SO THAT HUMAN BEINGS DISPLEASE GOD IN EVERY ACT AND DISPOSITION.

SIN IS UNIVERSAL

EVERY HUMAN BEING HAS INHERITED A SINFUL NATURE FROM ADAM. THIS IS WHAT IS KNOWN AS ORIGINAL SIN.

SEE 1 Kings 8:46

"SIN" AND "SINS"

WE COMMIT ACTS OF SIN (SINS) BECAUSE WE POSSESS A SIN NATURE.

LAW

GREEK TERM: NOMOS HEBREW TERM: TORAH "TEACHING, DIRECTION"

FUNCTION OF THE LAW

Therefore, by the deeds of the law no flesh will be justified in His sight, for by the law is the knowledge of sin. (Romans 3:20)

"IN THE LAW OR UNDER THE LAW"

TO BE IN (OR UNDER) THE LAW IS TO BE UNDER THE SPECIAL INFLUENCE OF THE LAW

Hearing and Doing (Verse 13)

Not the Hearers but the doers of the law will be just before God.

"You shall therefore keep My statutes and My judgments, which if a man does, he shall live by them: I am the LORD". Leviticus 18:5

TO BE JUST OR RIGHTEOUS (V. 13)

TO BE JUST IN THE SIGHT OF GOD IS TO STAND INNOCENT BEFORE GOD AND BE FREE FROM THE PUNISHMENT OF THE LAW

THE LAW WRITTEN IN THE HEART

CONSCIENCE PERFOMS IN THE GENTILE WORLD ROUGHLY THE SAME FUNCTION AS THE LAW PERFORMS AMONG THE JEWS

LIFE TRUTH

The law cannot give anyone the ability to obey God. It can only show us our sin and condemn us. We all are in the same predicament. We all have sinned though under different circumstances in relation to the law.

LIFE TRUTH

GOD WILL JUDGE EACH PERSON BY WHAT THEY INDIVIDUALLY KNOW TO BE THEIR DUTY.

LIFE TRUTH

ANY PREACHING OF THE GOSPEL THAT EXCLUDES THE JUDGMENT OF GOD IS NOT THE NEW TESTAMENT GOSPEL.
