25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. ²⁶ And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. Do you believe this?" John 11:25-26 (NKJV)

1 CORINTHIANS 15:20-28

JESUS IS THE FIRSTFRUITS OF THE HARVEST.

²⁰ But now Christ is risen from the dead and has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep. ²¹ For since by man came death, by Man also came the resurrection of the dead. ²² For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive.

²³ But each one in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, afterward those who are Christ's at His coming. ²⁴ Then comes the end, when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father, when He puts an end to all rule and all authority and power.

²⁵ For He must reign till He has put all enemies under His feet. 26 The last enemy that will be destroyed is death. 27 For "He has put all things under His feet." But when He says "all things are put under Him," it is evident that He who put all things under Him is excepted.

Now when all things are made subject to Him, then the Son Himself will also be subject to Him who put all things under Him, that God may be all in all.

THE FEAST OF FIRSTFRUITS Leviticus 23:9-14

⁹ And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, 10 "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: When you come into the land which I give to you, and reap its harvest, then you shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest to the priest.

THE FEAST OF FIRSTFRUITS Leviticus 23:9-14

11 He shall wave the sheaf before the LORD, to be accepted on your behalf; on the day after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it. 12 And you shall offer on that day, when you wave the sheaf, a male lamb of the first year, without blemish, as a burnt offering to the LORD.

THE FEAST OF FIRSTFRUITS Leviticus 23:9-14

13 Its grain offering shall be twotenths of an ephah of fine flour mixed with oil, an offering made by fire to the LORD, for a sweet aroma; and its drink offering shall be of wine, one-fourth of a hin.

THE FEAST OF FIRSTFRUITS Leviticus 23:9-14

14 You shall eat neither bread nor parched grain nor fresh grain until the same day that you have brought an offering to your God; it shall be a statute forever throughout your generations in all your dwellings.

CHRIST IS THE FIRSTFRUITS.

JUST AS THE FIRST SHEAF WAS A TOKEN OF MANY MORE THAT WOULD FOLLOW, IN THE SAME WAY, CHRIST'S RESURRECTION IS A PLEDGE OF A MULTITUDE OF OTHERS WHO WILL LIKEWISE BE REURRECTED.

SUNDAY

THE OFFERING OF THE FIRSTFRUITS TOOK PLACE THE DAY AFTER THE SABBATH, THAT IS, SUNDAY. THIS OF COURSE IS THE DAY CHRIST WAS RESURRECTED.
